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## What is the ATC?



- It is a center where students come to take career related classes.
- There are over 20 different pathways available to students.
- Students from all four Denton ISD schools as well as 6 smaller districts attend the ATC.
- Most classes are available for 11th or 12th grade students.
- Most classes or programs offer industry based certifications or licensures for students.

## What is the schedule like at the ATC?

- The ATC is on a modified block schedule. This means you will attend class every other day.
- You will be scheduled for class on an A or B day.
- There are morning classes 8:25 am- 11 am or afternoon 12:25 pm- 2:45 pm.
- Classes last about 2 ½ hours and most teachers will give a break time to the students each class.



## What about class fees?

- All ATC classes have course fees.
- These course fees cover the supplies needed for your ATC class.
- Class fees range from \$10-\$5500 (this is for the dual credit Fire Academy)
- Course fees are to be paid during the 1st two weeks of school unless you are told otherwise.
