Each student in current Grade 9, Grade 10 and Grade 11 will receive the Dual Credit Process and Forms in their 2021-2022 Course Selection Packet. Student will receive these packets the Week of February 15-19 through their Social Studies class !

2020-2021 Aubrey High School Dual Credit Process

Aubrey High School has a partnership with NCTC and TWU for the 2021-2022 school year. Students in Grades 10-12 next year, meet the requirements and return all the forms by the deadline are able to enroll in Dual Credit courses. Dual Credit is a college course for which a student can earn college and high school credit for that same course. Parents and students are encourage to view the **2021-2022 Dual Credit General Information** presentation posted on the Counselors page of the AHS website. After meeting requirements and completing the approval process, students will register and pay tuition online.

The intent of this presentation is to guide students through each step of that process.

The deadline for all the required Dual Credit forms is April 23, 2021.

2020-2021 Aubrey High School Dual Credit Process

We currently offer multiple courses through North Central Texas College (NCTC) which is an area two-year college. We currently offer 2 math courses (which can be taken as a 4th Math) through Texas Woman's University (TWU) which is a 4-year college. A list of possible courses will be listed at the end of this presentation.

2020-2021 Aubrey High School Dual Credit Process

_____ 1. Does the student have a 2.000 or above high school GPA?

If you are not sure of your current GPA, you can request an unofficial copy of your high school transcript. You can find the ***AHS Transcript Request Form*** in the admin office or on the website. The GPA that is currently posted is the GPA to determine if you are eligible to enroll in Dual Credit. There will be no changes to your GPA until you earn credits at the end of this school year.

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- _____ 2. Apply to NCTC and/or TWU by submitting a college application using www.applytexas.org. You will complete a 2-year application for NCTC and a 4-year application for TWU.

You will be applying for Fall, 2021.

PLEASE be sure to use the email address that you will check on a regular basis. We encourage you to NOT use your aubreyisd.net email. After submission you will receive an email from APPLYTEXAS that your application has been received and sent to the college.

You should then receive communication directly from the college to make you aware if you have been accepted and how to set up your student account. PLEASE be sure you keep this email to reference at a later date.

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If you are currently enrolled in a Dual Credit course as a Grade 10 or Grade 11 student AND you are a student in *good standing* (you are passing and have paid tuition), you are NOT required to re-apply to NCTC.

You will need to complete and return a DC Registration Form!

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- _____ 3. **VERY IMPORTANT!** After you have submitted your application to NCTC and/or TWU, you need to send Mrs. Holloway an email documenting that your application has been submitted.

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- _____4. AFTER you have received your acceptance communication, you will be required to EMAIL a copy of your TSI, ACT or SAT scores to Susan Holloway at sholloway@aubreyisd.net. Be sure you have met the Required score by comparing your scores to the TSI and Exemptions Page. There is a hard copy in your Course Selection Packet or you can View this form in the 2021-2022 Dual Credit Section on the website. 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_____5. The college(s) will need an official copy of your Aubrey High School Transcript. Aubrey High School will send one on your behalf.

The transcript that will be sent includes grades and GPA through Semester 1 of the 2021-2022 school year.

_____6. You will complete the NCTC Registration Form and/or the TWU Registration form and email a copy to Susan Holloway at sholloway@aubreyisd.net.

Please note that this form only gives you permission to register!

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_____7. Register for you classes

You will still need to register online for your classes at NCTC and/or TWU.

Mrs. Holloway will share step-by-step instructions for how to register online per college.

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_____8. Pay tuition or set up a payment plan

Most colleges expect tuition payment or setting up a payment plan at the time of registering for classes. Note: As of the time of publication of this Information, both NCTC and/or TWU have reduced or waived tuition for students who qualify for the AISD Free/Reduced Lunch Program.
