

Aubrey ISD Prekindergarten Partnership Proposal

In response to House Bill 3 requirements regarding Prekindergarten Partnerships, Aubrey ISD is requesting proposals from eligible learning centers who are interested in potentially establishing a partnership.

The purpose of any potential partnership would be to provide eligible four-year-old students with full day prekindergarten services. These eligible students will be served in the child care program, but dual enrolled in Aubrey ISD.

The current proposal is open to providers that meet the following minimum state criteria:

Nationally accredited;

Texas Rising Star program 3 or higher;

Head Start Provider;

Texas School Ready participant; or

Meet the prekindergarten program requirements under TEC 29.1532

In addition to meeting the minimum state criteria, the learning centers will be required to meet Aubrey ISD standards for high quality prekindergarten services.
