2020-21 Aubrey Basketball Home Game Procedures

We look forward to seeing you at our upcoming basketball game at the AHS Gymnasium. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Aubrey ISD has added several protocols and guidelines to our gameday experience to ensure a safe environment. Please look over the below information before attending a Chaparral basketball game. We will be following the Aubrey ISD UIL Activities Protocol and UIL guidelines.

Face Coverings - Per UIL guidelines, all fans entering Aubrey High School must wear a face covering. AISD will enforce the wearing of face coverings and social distancing for all spectators.

COVID Screenings - Per UIL guidelines, all fans entering Aubrey High School for a basketball game are required to be screened for COVID-19 symptoms. Fans will see signs on doors, asking if they have or been in close contact with anyone showing COVID-19 symptoms. Aubrey ISD staff will also be checking temperatures before spectators can enter the gymnasium.

Parking - Please see attached map for home parking. Fans are asked to park behind the high school in areas marked primary spectator parking and secondary spectator parking.

There will be changes to parking in January 2021 due to construction.

Team Buses - Visiting teams will enter the gym from the west side of campus and exit to their bus on the west side to maintain separation from non-participants.

Visiting team buses can drop off teams behind the school, following the loop and in front of the side entrance. Visiting team buses can park in the overflow parking in the area marked yellow on the map. Buses can park up visiting teams in the place that they dropped off.

Locker room - Locker rooms will be disinfected before and after the competition.

Ticket Sales - The basketball gymnasium capacity has been reduced by 50% in compliance with the Governor's Executive Order. The main gym will permit 250 spectators on the home side and 250 on the visitors' side with priority given to participants' families.

Aubrey ISD will utilize an online ticket purchasing vendor (TicketSpicket) for all Aubrey ISD sporting events, including Aubrey Middle School games.

The ticket prices will be \$3 for adults and \$2 for students.

District and senior citizen passes will be accepted at home games.

Streaming - All home AHS basketball games will be streamed during the 2020-21 season by NFHS. Varsity and junior varsity games that are played in the main gym will be streamed by NFHS, a subscription service.

Seating - Seating in the main gymnasium is limited to 500 spectators, 250 on each side. Aubrey ISD requests fans social distance and sit at least two seats away from people outside their household. Spectators are asked to sit with household members in areas designated with blue tape. To maintain social distancing, students younger than high school age will need to be accompanied by an adult.

Home Student Section - To maintain social distancing, the student bleacher section in the main gym will be available to 12 students. High School students can also sit with their household elsewhere.

Aubrey ISD will enforce the wearing of face coverings and social distancing for all spectators.

We ask that at the conclusion of the game, spectators exit the gymnasium and refrain from congregating together in the foyer. If you are waiting on your student to take them home, please social distance from those not in your household.

Restrooms/Concessions - Restrooms and concessions are available for fans in the gym foyer.
